



SLT Meeting Minutes
December 10, 2024

Mrs. Chang welcomed everyone to the December SLT Meeting.

- **Review November Minutes**

November minutes were sent out and reviewed by all members. The minutes were agreed upon and passed.

- **CEP – MOY in progress**

Mrs. Parada presented the CEP. Students will begin the Middle of the Year diagnostics for i-Ready and Acadience. Families will receive results when diagnostics are finished.

- **Smaller class size plan**

Mrs. Chang informed us that the smaller class size mandate will be in effect for all grades in September. All grades will have a cap of 20-23 students. Grades K-2 will be capped at 20 students per class. Grades 3-5 will have up to 23 students in each class. Additionally, there will be classes added to all grades to accommodate these numbers. We will need 7.25 more teachers. Mrs. Chang explained that we may need to hire a teacher F-status for 2-3 days a week to accommodate the students' needs. Two new cluster teachers will be added. Mrs. Chang said that a second physical education and a dance teacher would be considered.

- **Lunch and Learn**

Mr. Chang discussed Lunch and Learn for upper grades starting in the new year. Mrs. Parada explained that letters would be going home. Digital applications as well as hard copies would be sent.

- **Arts Programs - Enrichment**

CWP after school has begun.

- **Afterschool**

Mrs. Parada informed us that the after-school program focused on preparation for state tests will begin in the new year. Applications will be sent to upper grades.

- **School Construction Update**

Mrs. Chang reported that the shades are being installed. The doors are locked for security purposes.

- **Safety and Security**

Ms. Samolis discussed the drills that have been done already. Teachers were informed of the opportunity for emergency training. Training will be in school.

- **Open House – Kindergarten**

Mrs. Chang informed us of the upcoming Kindergarten Open House. Families will be given the opportunity to visit the new school building.

- **Open Forum**

Parents asked about the alarms that have continued to go off in the neighborhood.
